Davies is exceptional in her candor and willingness to look at both transference and counter-transference in her own experience. Our discussions will include specifically looking at the experience of the therapist responding to both transferences and their own counter-transferences. There are several papers by Davies that we might also consider.

In addition to her writing there will be other papers that we will be reading that examine the various dimensions of sexual development as it appears in sessions.

We will also where possible employ the use of films as our own creative effort to enliven our understanding and develop our uses of these theories.

This seminar is open to anyone accepted into supervision and anticipating their work with clients or currently seeing clients.
