Course description

The British pediatrician and psychoanalyst Donald Winnicott (1896-1971) is appreciated for his monumental contributions to psychoanalytic and psychodynamic theory and practice. This yearlong concentration is an opportunity to consider these contributions with greater focus. For this course we will closely read from important selected papers of Winnicott's, as well as a sampling of writings by other thinkers who have generated compelling theoretical expansions of Winnicott's ideas (e.g., Ogden, Bollas, Eigen, etc). We will examine common clinical issues through the lens of Winnicott's thinking; students will help lead individual meetings via presentations.
