Psychodynamics of Race

Course Description:

With this course we will continue a dialogue at CTP of the ways in which race, culture and difference takes up space in our work of psychotherapy.

We are seasoned in working with oppression on a familial level—working with individuals whose internal schemas are built around fear and shame. What about collective experiences of oppression, fear and shame? These experiences are often implicit, embedded and internalized as part of our social fabric. And because these dynamics are often unconscious, we can vacillate between being the oppressor and the oppressed.

We will look at writings not just in the psychoanalytic literature such as Fakhry Davids but will look at authors such as Angela Davies, bell hooks, Lola Olufemi, Sara Ahmed, and Franz Fanon to place our work in a larger context.
