Course description:

The British pediatrician and psychoanalyst Donald Winnicott (1896-1971) is appreciated for his monumental contributions to psychoanalytic and psychodynamic theory and practice. This yearlong course is an opportunity to consider these contributions with greater focus. We will closely read from important selected papers of Winnicott's, as well as engage other thinkers who have generated compelling theoretical expansions of Winnicott's ideas. Winnicott's writing, evocative and emotionally powerful, can feel both timely and timeless. His work, rooted in the canon and early settings of psychoanalysis, also reflects some of its classical exclusions and omissions. Students are expected to bring their evolving contemporary, anti-oppressive, intersectional, and socially informed analytic framework for our discussions in addressing Winnicott's work. Common clinical issues will be explored through the lens of Winnicott's thinking; students will help lead individual meetings via presentations.
