## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

In this course, participants focus on using Jung's typology in psychotherapy.

The course is based largely on live interviews with Jung now available on YouTube, supplemented by passages from his writings. The course offers and opportunity for Students to learn about his depth understanding of the dualities: Introvert/Extravert; Intuition/Sensation; Feeling/Thinking, and Perception/Judgment, and how they can be applied in therapy practice. Emphasis on Intuition as it applies to all types.



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The course also shows the connection between Jung's ideas and the Myers' Briggs Type Indicator

Learning Objectives: By the end of this course students should be able to:

Understand Jung's teaching on the archetypes

Integrate a working knowledge how to apply this knowledge to clinical practice.

Help clients see the action of types in their daily lives.

Evaluate the usefulness of the Myers' Briggs Type Indicator.
